Artistic Break – Experience AoP in Action (20–30 min)

Invite a culture facilitator to facilitate an activity that would or could be an AoP activity, make sure it
involves the interaction of the stakeholders, so they gain a true sense and understanding of the AoP
concept.

Collaborative Workshops (30 min)

In smaller mixed stakeholder groups discuss one of the following topics:

- Understanding AoP:
 - Share your interpretation of AoP
 - Identify common and different understandings of AoP
 - Facilitator captures key points on flipcharts
- Mapping Resources & Roles:
 - What resources are needed to implement AoP locally?
 - Who should lead, coordinate, and support?
 - What resources exist or are missing?
 - Ideas for funding, partnerships, and sustainability

Plenary Reflections (20 min)

- Each group shares key insights
- Open plenum
 - What role do you see yourself playing in AoP?
 - What support or knowledge do you need to contribute meaningfully? This could be more
 information about the concept, about health, social, economic outcomes, and/or the need for
 skills development (link workers and culture and arts facilitators)
