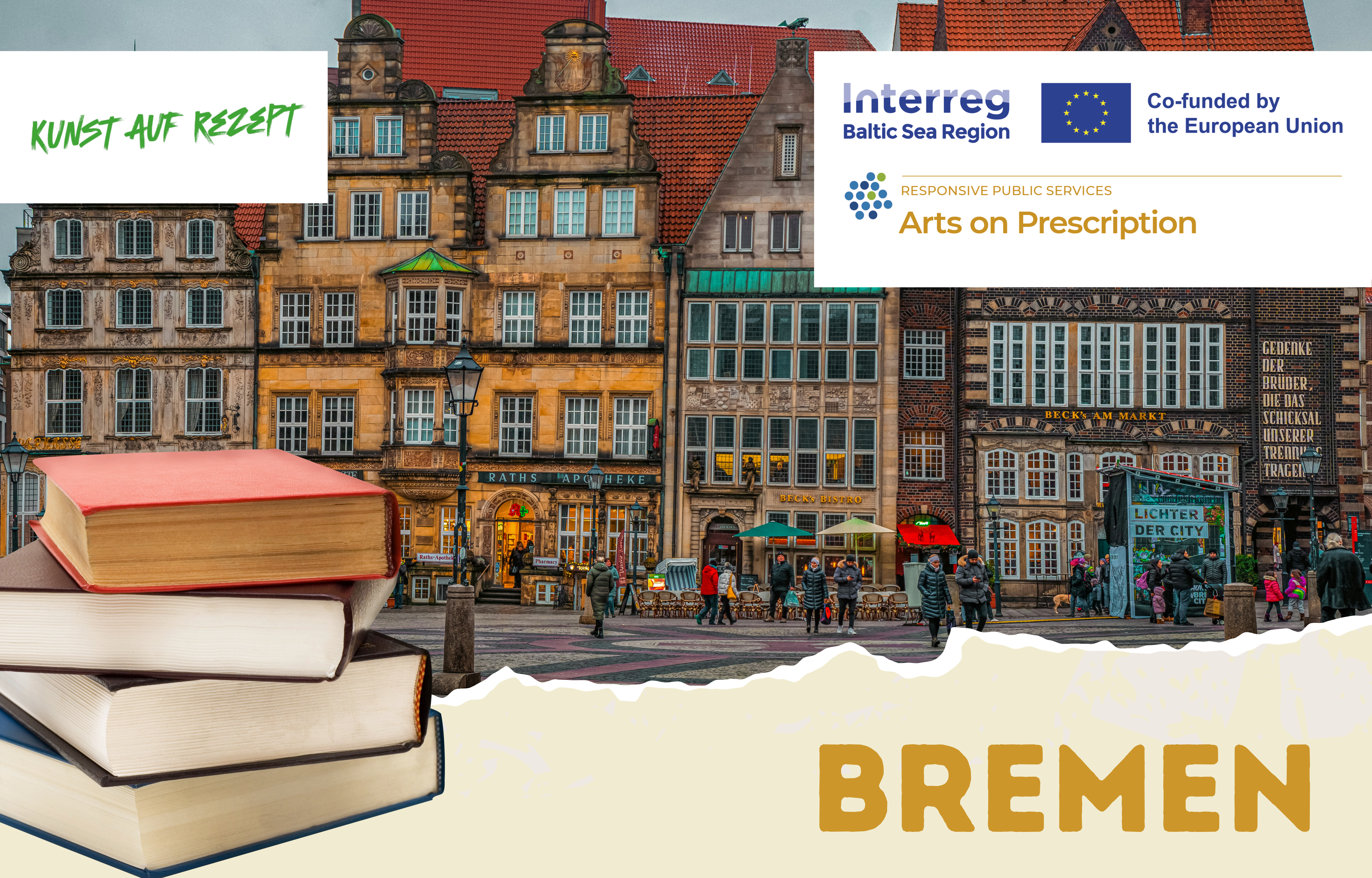

BREMEN

OBJECTIVE

Since regular, long-term funding is currently not in reach in Bremen due to tight public budgets, the project partners will implement further actions to maintain cooperation within the established structures, promote the AoP concept at a policy and practical level beyond Bremen, and acquire project funding for the continuation of AoP programmes in Bremen.

TASKS / ACTION

Action 1: Foundation of a Bremen based Centre of Expertise for Arts & Health

Creating a new platform that incorporates the structure of the AoP project (steering group, advisory board and broader network) in order to continue cooperation and to further promote and develop the field of arts and health and the AoP concept.

Action 2: AoP Project Development

Working towards project-based funding in order to be able to continue implementing the AoP concept in Bremen and to further adopt it to different contexts and target groups.

Action 3: Transferring AoP within the Adult Education Centre network

Creating platforms and working groups within the nationwide network of Adult Education Centres and their umbrella organisations on federal state level for awareness raising, capacity building and transferring the AoP concept to other cities/regions in Germany.

Action 4: Fostering Policy Making Processes

Promoting the AoP concept within the psychiatry working group of representatives from the federal states and advocating for the inclusion of arts and cultural activities in the revision of the nationwide prevention act.
