



# REGION NORRBOTTEN AND SUNDERBY FOLK HIGH SCHOOL

## OBJECTIVE

Secure long-term, shared funding for Arts on Prescription (AoP) across Norrbotten, involving all municipalities and Region Norrbotten. Boost understanding of AoP's benefits among key stakeholders such as decision-makers, culture and healthcare professionals and citizens. Develop Norrbotten's role in national and transnational knowledge exchange regarding AoP and the field of culture and health.

## TASKS / ACTION

### 1. Secure Sustainable AoP Funding

Action: Present a clear funding model and conduct knowledge-raising meetings with key strategic actors.

Target Group: The National System for Knowledge Management, the Regional Development Committee, the Health and Medical Services Committee, and other decision-makers within Region Norrbotten's health/medical services and culture department.

### 2. Boost Knowledge & Awareness

Action: Increase understanding of AoP's benefits by conducting workshops and targeted meetings.

Communicate project results and AoP's effects through various media channels.

### 3. Expand Knowledge Exchange & Best Practices

Action: Actively participate in the national Swedish Culture & Health network and the ArtWell Net project (knowledge exchange between Nordic/Baltic countries and Ukraine).
