

### **OBJECTIVE**

Odense Municipality's goal is to continue to provide Arts on Prescription or similar arts initiatives to promote mental health and wellbeing in the municipality. Odense municipality aims to:

- Promoting better collaboration between the culture, health, & social sectors.
- Engaging general practitioners in referring to social prescribing i.e. arts on prescription activities.
- building collaboration nationally and internationally to exchange knowledge and experience among a broader network in the area of Arts on Prescription.
- securing funding from national and regional sources to advance long term arts on prescription programmes including the agreements made by KulturRegion Fyn/Cultural Region Funen.

## TASKS / ACTION

#### **Action 1 Cultural Agreements**

Financing and promoting arts initiatives across nine municipalities for new audiences & for all citizens. The initiatives are co-funded by the Ministry of Culture and Kulturregion Fyn/ Cultural Region Funen

#### **Action 2: Culture Room for youths**

An Arts on Prescription initiative for young people not engaged in education or employment, with the aim of promoting social inclusion, mental wellbeing, and pathways to re-engagement.

#### Action 3: National Alliance for Culture and Health

Partner in establishing a national Culture and Health Alliance to strengthen cross-sectoral commitment and inform and advance policy development

#### Action 4: Social Prescribing – a national model

Advocating for the integration of the arts into the emerging national model for social prescribing in Denmark, to enhance holistic approaches to health and well-being.

#### Action 5: Partner in BSR Mental Health Platform

A mental health platform to facilitate knowledge exchange on Arts on Prescription practices across the Baltic Sea Region, aimed at advancing the evidence base and innovation in arts and health.


