

OBJECTIVE

To address the needs of the local population and advance the Arts on Prescription programme, Polish partners will implement activities that aim to:

- raising awareness of art-based social prescribing among stakeholders in culture, health, science and public administration, as well as nongovernmental organisations and the public;
- building collaboration nationally and internationally to share knowledge and develop a network of supporters for 'Arts on Prescription'.
- securing funding from national and regional sources to facilitate knowledge transfer between art facilitators and cultural institutions.

TASKS / ACTION

Action 1: Arts for Health and well-being Network (ArtWellNet) project Building a network of people who support the further implementation of 'Arts on Prescription' programmes.

Action 2: The joint position of the Convention of Marshals of Voivodeships of the Republic of Poland

Obtain interregional support to facilitate knowledge transfer and implement the 'Arts on Prescription' programme in Poland.

Action 3: Back2Woods project - Rediscovering South Baltic Forests as Places for Mental Healing and Active Recreation

Building knowledge and sharing experiences, which is crucial for establishing long-lasting Arts on Prescription programmes.

Action 4: Establishment of a micro-grant fund for the implementation of the **Arts on Prescription programme**

Enrich regional cultural institutions with the Arts on Prescription programme.
